TUITION SURCHARGE - IS NO MORE

Good News! As of July 1, the tuition surcharge legislation (since 1994) has been repealed. We will no longer surcharge undergraduate students beyond 140 hours. It still remains in their best interest to finish as quickly as possible, so they can take advantage of the eight semesters (less if prorated) of fixed tuition. Please share this information with your colleagues. We don't edit the catalog after publication, so this will be removed with the 2020-21 catalog. Websites referencing tuition surcharge are being edited, removing mention of this former state requirement. The criteria for a tuition surcharge waiver is also the criteria for a fixed tuition appeal, so be careful how website language is edited.
