At that time, we will deactivate and migrate these ~3 petitions into the new system. Additional FAQs and a Canvas training module are being developed.

Based on the volume of students using CAPP and the proposed phase out of CAPP, we are discontinuing this email account. If there are questions related to CAPP, please use graduation@uncc.edu. If there are references to this email on your website or in PDF documents, please make this change. This removal will take effect on August 17.

SCHEDULING UPDATE

The Office of the Registrar is looking to finish the hybrid and simulcast course splits by the time you read this. The initial section (*called parent*) has been split into 2-3 sections (*called child*), after which students from the parent section will be moved to the child sections. This meets a couple of objectives beyond social distancing: 1) students will see which day they need to be in the classroom on their schedule and 2) we know where students are, to assist with contact tracing. Child sections will be crosslisted and will inherit the course shell/content from the parent (*CTL is managing this move*). The diagrams on page 3 are a rough visual as to what is occurring. After a thorough review, OneIT will be helping us move students to the new child sections. If you have a section for which you (the instructor) are splitting, you are welcome to share that information with the Office of the Registrar and we can align that with the student's schedule. If your splits are different each meeting time, that will need to be managed between instructor and student.
