We have the highest number of campus projects in the OneIT hopper because we're constantly submitting ideas for improvements and many of those originate from our partners. Keep those ideas coming.


FIVE-YEAR ACADEMIC CALENDAR APPROVED

The Faculty Council & Chancellor's Cabinet just approved the 5-year calendar, and it has been posted. Spring breaks for 2023-2024 and 2025-2026 were changed to align between half terms. Parts of term dates are now included and will be going forward. And, of course, we have our normal addition of the fifth year (2026-2027).

SCHEDULE WIZARD - SEARCH BY COURSE NUMBER

There was recent question from our partners in the College of Education. "Is there a way for students to search the course schedule for the new general education courses by course number?" For example, if a student needs an XXXX 1501 course, could they enter the course number 1501, and view all courses with that number? Might be a big ask but could be very beneficial.

Great news! The request to search for courses by course number is now in production! We've tested this new look-up tool and it works great. Please see the screenshot below. Self-Service Banner has always had this option, but now Schedule Wizard does too.



SCHEDULE WIZARD - HEADER CHANGE

To ensure the 'Seats Remaining' (formerly Seats Open) and 'Waitlist Seats Remaining' (formerly Waitlist Seats Open) language in Schedule Wizard is consistent with the language used in Self-Service, we updated the column headers in Schedule Wizard. These changes have been made. See the example below.
