DEPARTMENT OF KINESIOLOGY (NAME CHANGE)

STUDENT TYPE DESCRIPTION/USAGE CHANGE

If you're familiar with Banner student types, the S code previously meant 'special non-degree seeking undergraduate'. The S type is being reclassified as simply 'special non-degree seeking' and is applicable to both graduate and undergraduate students.

DEPARTMENT CHAIRS AND/OR PROGRAM DIRECTORS

The Office of the Registrar sends course cleanup reports to Schedule Builders (those in departments who input the schedule into Banner) routinely for three months leading up to the scheduling deadline. During the last week, this report is sent daily. Please work with your schedule builder, supplying as much of the scheduling details, as possible, so that the information can be entered and checked for errors before Schedule Builders lose access.

COURSES NOT OFFERED IN 10 YEARS

At the Faculty Council's September meeting, the course status (rule #9) portion of the <u>Course Numbering and Status Policy</u> was updated with a sunset clause. "A course that is not offered within a period of 10 years will be removed from the Catalog and inactivated." We will reach out to provide two options before that action occurs. Departments will need to either 1) offer the course in year 10 or 2) petition your College's Associate Dean.

Initially, The Office of the Registrar will be identifying courses that are at or have exceeded the 10-year mark. If a department wishes to retain a course on that list, a petition will be needed. More information will be provided when that list is produced.

Note: This list will be sent to department chairs.

PASS/NO CREDIT DEADLINE EXTENSION

The Faculty Council, at its October meeting, approved an extension of the Pass/No Credit deadline. Previously, the student request deadline was the last day of drop/add. The deadline has now been extended until the withdrawal deadline. This change is effective Spring 2022.

Note: This is unrelated to the pandemic exception that expired in Summer 2021.

NEW ONLINE SUSPENDED STUDENTS APPEAL TOOL FOR UNDERGRADUATES - EFFECTIVE WITH THE FALL 2021 TERM - TRAINING REGISTRATION LINK PROVIDED BELOW

A team of Enrollment Management and Academic Advising staff have been working together, in conjunction with OneIT, to create a streamlined Appeal Tool to provide students with a user-friendly portal to submit appeals. The tool also includes an online process for departmental primary and alternate contacts to review and make decisions for each appeal.

In May, the team launched the Financial Aid SAP Appeal, and mid-November the Academic Suspension Appeal will be added to the tool.
