CLARIFICATION ON CLASS ATTENDANCE AND REGISTRATION POLICIES

We have received inquiries regarding students attending classes without formal registration. This often occurs when instructors add students to Canvas or grant informal permission for students to sit in on classes.

To ensure compliance with University policy, and in consultation with the General Counsel's Office, we must reiterate that allowing students to attend classes without proper registration is prohibited.

Our <u>undergraduate</u> and <u>graduate</u> catalogs clearly state that registration and payment of associated fees are mandatory for all students attending classes, including those auditing courses.

The Board of Governors (BOG) Policy 1000.4.1, which addresses auditing, specifically applies to individuals aged 65 and older, designated as "senior auditors." This policy, based on GS 115B-2.2, exempts these senior auditors from registration and fee requirements. This exemption implies that all other individuals are required to formally register and pay applicable fees to attend classes.

Therefore, instructors are requested to ensure all students attending their classes are officially registered.
