New Campus Student Program Changes, Substitutions, and Waiver Rhythms (Reminder)

In preparation for CPOS, Charlotte is introducing new best practices and timelines for Student Program Changes (e.g. change of major, minor, catalog year, etc.) as well as for Substitution and Waiver academic petitions.

Student Program Changes (SPCs), Substitutions, and Waivers should now be submitted during registration for the upcoming semester. The last date that an SPC, Substitution, or Waiver may be submitted for Spring 2026 is **January 16, 2026** (five business days prior to census). SPCs, Substitutions, and Waivers submitted after this date will still be processed; however, they will not be reflected in the student's CPOS aid eligibility until the following term.

Chancellor's and Dean's List Awareness:

Please note that the Records team plans to run the Chancellor's and Dean's List process on January 14, 2026. At that point, the website will be live with the list of names, and students will be informed.

Academic Calendar Update: Last Day to Withdraw*

The last day to withdraw from courses, for the Full and Second Half (H2) Summer 2026 part-of-terms, has been updated on the Academic Calendar. The revised dates are listed below.

- Full term - **July 1, 2026**
- Second Half term (H2) - **July 20, 2026**

*As a result of this change, the 'Last day to Change Grade Type' and the 'Last day to Change or Opt-Out of Grade Replacement' dates for the Full and Second Half terms have also been updated to the same dates, respectively.

New Attribute Code for Artificial Intelligence

A new attribute code has been created to identify course sections with AI content. The new code is ARIN - Artificial Intelligence, and can be added at the section level in Banner. Students can search for classes with this attribute by clicking the 'Advanced Search' option and then selecting Artificial Intelligence in the 'Attribute Type' field.
