**Transient Study Petition Tip**

When students utilize the transient study petition, the courses they select come from our database, also represented in the Transfer Credit Advisor. As a reviewer, please pay close attention to the course title. If it contains a reference to (**<1997**), this means the **course is no longer offered at the community college**. It exists in our database if a student presents this course from that time period (pre-Banner). This is not an option for current students. We are unable to hide these options when students are selecting within the petition, and it's not expected that they would know this. We're sharing in case you see them when reviewing. Students should be advised to select a different course, or you can simply deny that course.
