**Academic Calendar Updates**

- The **Summer I 2026 (H1) grading deadline is now June 25 @ 5 pm**. The previous deadline was June 29 @ noon. Summer II (H2) classes begin on June 29. The date was adjusted to allow more time for grade processing and prerequisite checking prior to the first day of Summer II. The [Academic Calendar](#) has been updated.
- The **Census Date for Fall 2026** enrollment has been updated from August 27th to **August 28th**. As a result of this change the **Niner Course Pack Last Day to Opt Out** date has also been updated to **August 28th**.

**Student Program Change Reminders**

To ensure our students' records are updated accurately and without delay, please keep these essential reminders in mind when submitting student program change requests:

- Use the 4-letter program codes in all program fields, including majors, minors, concentrations and certificate programs, which can be found in the following [document](#). Do not use program titles - only the Banner codes.
- Include the proper degree codes when both adding and dropping majors, as there are many programs that have a BS and BA in the same program.
- Ensure you list both the Approver AND the Submitter in all requests. Even if you are acting as both, both fields must be completed to process the request.
- Include both the college AND department names in the appropriate fields, if applicable.
- The effective term must be the current term or later. Once the last day of classes has passed for the current term, please begin using the next term as the effective term; i.e., end of 202610, use 202260.
- Students enrolled in a meta major, UCOL, or HPEX, must have that major dropped if changing to a discipline-specific major, so please indicate dropping one of these majors on the request.

**Now Available: Grade Replacement Petition (NEW)**

A dedicated [Grade Replacement](#) petition type is now live. This new petition type allows Advisors to manually request Grade Replacement for course pairings not selected during the Grade Replacement autoselect process. This covers scenarios such as:

- Late-added courses
- Topics courses or non-equivalent pairings
- Changes to course subjects, numbers, or equivalencies

### Searching for American Democracy courses?

Effective April 22, 2026, students can find courses that meet the Foundations of American Democracy requirement by searching for "American Democracy" as an Attribute Type in Self-Service Banner. Students were having trouble finding the appropriate courses meeting this requirement. They don't always know to search for the course number 1575, another search option. This should eliminate a pain point for this requirement.
