Please only reach out if you need immediate assistance with equivalent credit related to advising. We are currently experiencing a 2-3 day processing window due to high volume. **Our priority: 1) Advising 2) Orientation, 3) Summer, then 4) Fall. Otherwise, it's based on when it arrived in our queue.** Slate pushes transcripts to us two times per day (5 am & 11:30 pm). In May & June 2025 combined, we saw 7,153 transcripts. That averages about 119 transcripts articulated per day. Thanks for your patience.

UPDATING TRANSFER EQUIVALENCIES

This is a friendly reminder that there are two methods for updating transfer equivalencies.

- If prior to matriculation, you can submit via a [Google Form](#). This is a faster way to request changes. No vetting steps are required.
- If after matriculation, you can submit a [Transfer Credit Adjustment Petition](#). This will require multiple vetting steps.

If a student is identified, we will update the student as indicated. Unless noted that this is unique only to this student, we will also update our database (aka Transfer Credit Advisor) with the requested change for future students.
