A warning email was sent to students regarding an overload in registration for Summer 2026 Second half term (H2) on June 25th. In an effort to provide students more time to adjust their registrations or submit Registration Hour Overload academic petitions, we dropped any Summer (H2) courses after the add/drop deadline.

This means students cannot re-add courses to their schedules after they have been dropped. You can always monitor students who are registered for greater than 7 hours using the Report Central Student - Catalog/Schedule report titled "Students with GT 7 hours in a Half Term with Petition Approvals".

Graduation Timeline—Summer 2026

- **July 1** - Last day to apply for August 2026 graduation @ 11:59pm
- **July 17** - Mid-term degree clearance reports from academic departments are due
- **August 13** - Awarding period for students with audits at 100% begins
- **August 14** - Email to students - Applied to Graduate, DegreeWorks NE 100%
- **August 18** - Deadline for submission of approved grades for incompletes, education abroad, and official transcripts for transient study.
- **August 28** - Census Date for Fall 2026 - students not cleared to graduate will be denied if application not updated to a future term

Schedule Wizard Decommissioned

Effective July 1, the Schedule Wizard tool has reached its end of life at UNC Charlotte. Students can continue to seamlessly search for classes and register for courses directly through [Student Self Service in MyCharlotte](#).

Advanced Placement (AP) Scores Have Arrived

AP scores are officially in! Received in bulk on July 1, these scores were uploaded to Banner, and our team is actively working to deduplicate the transferred credits today, July 2. Census Date Alignment

To realign with [UNC System policy](#), scheduled Saturday classes will now be included in the Census date calculation beginning in Spring 2027. Consequently, the Census date for both Fall and Spring semesters will officially be designated as the 10th class day.
